



The **NYS Historic Homeowner Tax Credit Program** will cover **20%** of qualified rehabilitation costs of **owner-occupied** historic houses, with a project minimum of \$5,000 and 5% spent on exterior work, up to a **credit value of \$50,000**.

This program requires that the building be individually listed in the State or National Register of Historic Places, or in a listed historic district. The building must also be located in a qualifying census tract.

You may be eligible if your historic home is located in Elmira's National Register Historic Districts: the Near Westside and the new Maple Avenue Historic District. Other homeowners may be eligible if their historic home is in one of the region's many National Register Historic Districts: South Side (Corning), Gansevoort/East Steuben Street(Bath), Horseheads 1855 Extension, Maple Street (Addison), Montour Falls, and Owego Central Historic Districts.
